G1. LARI WITH PASTA, CASTLE & PROSCIUTTO – for foodies

A half-day tour to discover the **enchanting Tuscan hilltop town of Lari**, offering a glimpse into the treasures of the "Terre di Pisa" region. **Lari is a little town with lots of hidden gems. Let's discover them together.**

Begin your journey by exploring the **renowned Martelli Pasta Factory**, a culinary gem in **operation since 1926**. **Meet Dino Martelli and his passionate family**, who uphold traditional pasta-making methods with profound respect. Learn about their philosophy of life and work, understanding why their pasta stands out.

Next, venture to the XIV-century Castello dei Vicari, overlooking the town center. Our guide will lead you through its historic halls, including an ancient prison, an old courtroom, and a frescoed hall. Marvel at the inner court adorned with coats of arms from Tuscany's influential families over the centuries.

A visit to a local butcher's shop unveils the secrets of curing prosciutto and salamis. The **butcher shares their expertise in crafting genuine meats using traditional techniques and natural products**, culminating in a delectable **tasting of their salami and prosciutto** and many other meat specialties.

G16. PECCIOLI & GHIZZANO: traditional and contemporary art, with wine tasting

Valdera sounds like a captivating destination, offering a **delightful blend of history, art, and tradition** and we are going to explore two typical villages.

Ghizzano, with its small population and **picturesque location**, seems like a hidden gem. Exploring contemporary artworks by Alicja Kwade and David Tremlett amid the **ancient charm of a 1,000-year-old village** is a unique experience. The **Counts Venerosi Pesciolini's historical villa** and **organic wine production** add a touch of aristocratic elegance to the visit. The family arrived in Ghizzano in the **14th Century** and still today live in the village.

We'll also have a walk in the **beautiful Italian gardens** right in front of the villa, restored at the beginning of the 20th century.

Peccioli, with its modern art scene featuring Hidetoshi Nagasawa, Daniel Buren, and Jeppe Hein, provides a striking contrast to the town historical richness, such as the main **church that dates back to the 12th century.**

In Peccioli the **Palazzo Senza Tempo and its suspended terrace** promise **breathtaking views of the Tuscan valley**, making it a must-visit.

The inclusion of a **typical Tuscan lunch at a local restaurant**, featuring regional specialties and wine, adds a delicious touch to the experience. It's a wonderful way to immerse oneself in the local culture and flavors while appreciating the beauty of Valdera.

G5. VOLTERRA & OLIVE OIL

A tour to the most ancient town of Tuscany, **Volterra**, with the tasting most traditional of the local produce: **extra virgin olive oil.**

The tour starts with the ancient town of Volterra, a world-famous location for its beautiful historical center. The town is resulting from 3 millenniums of civilization, from the Etruscans and the Romans through the medieval Municipalities and the Renaissance time. You'll be crossing stunning squares, entering a sumptuous cathedral (ticket entrance to be paid onsite), visiting alabaster workshops or staring at the Roman or Etruscan ruins. At the oil mill, located a few kms from the town, our guide gives you an interesting and detailed introduction to the world of extra virgin olive oils, from the methods of cultivation of the trees to the techniques for extraction from the olives, before entering the mill to see the machinery and the technology used for production. The guide will show you how to taste and identify a real and genuine extra virgin olive oil and how to differentiate it from commercial olive oils. The tasting is accompanied by a full lunch with local specialties.

G9. PICK NICK AT THE TEMPLE & HILLTOP VILLAGES

Let's visit together some **typical villages off the beaten path and experience the most authentic Tuscany**. Palaia is a small village on a hill that dominates the whole district of the former Pisan domains. We start with a walk through the rural town of Palaia, that allows you to experience **the atmosphere of small villages in Italy**, one of the most important elements of the "Italian way of life". The tour guide brings you to the **charming village of Montefoscoli**, **a fantastic location where time seems to have stopped to centuries ago**. Here you will visit a very interesting **museum dedicated to the local farming culture in the historical palace** of the local landlords. The museum shows all aspects of the farmers life and the development of the village from a rural community to our days. The last destination of this tour is the **masonic temple of Minerva Medica**, in the private property of the noble family of Montefoscoli. A very original construction with lots of symbolic meanings in an enchanting wood of ancient oak trees. **Enjoy a delectable picnic curated by our local cook**, featuring an array of fresh and seasonal delights. From fresh vegetables to pasta, paninis, and flavorful frittatas, along with the wines from the **panoramic farm**.




